**RULES**

**Judging**

- Judges will be selected by a committee comprised of the Host and Sponsoring Departments.
- Any scoring disputes shall be made to the judge immediately after the run.

**Eligibility**

- The competition is open to Law Enforcement Officers who are currently certified to operate a police motorcycle
- Space is limited to 8 entries per agency; with an event maximum of 80 riders

**Clothing and Conduct**

- Riders must dress appropriately. Boots, helmets, and eye protection must be worn at all times during practice and competition.
- Standard duty uniform must be worn on competition day.
- All riders shall act in a professional manner. Inappropriate behavior could result in disqualification from the event.

**Classes of Competition**

- Harley-Davidson Police model with windshield.
- Harley-Davidson Police model with fairing (does not include Dyna-Glide).
- Open (Honda, BMW, Kawasaki, etc.).

Class #1 and #2 could be combined due to number of entries. Exception will be considered on an individual bases.

**Motorcycles**

- Motorcycles must be operating properly with no excessive or obvious oil leaks or mechanical problems. All motorcycles are subject to a mechanical inspection.
- Modifications for the purpose of competition are not allowed.
- Repair time of 5 minutes or motorcycle replacement will be allowed prior to starting the event. If a break-down occurs during competition the judge will determine if it was caused by malfunction or rider skill. The judge may allow the rider a re-ride. Clutch failure does not justify a re-ride.

**Competition/Scoring**

- The competition is a timed event. The fastest time wins.
- Each participant will be given 3 runs through the course. The best time of all 3 rides and any penalty time will be added for their final time.
- Penalty assessment
  - Moving cone from base w/o knocking over = 1 second
  - Knocking cone over = 2 seconds
  - Putting foot down = 4 seconds
  - Stopping in pattern and using feet to move motorcycle= 10 seconds
  - Riding out of pattern and not re-entering at the start of the pattern= 15 seconds
  - Bike down= 20 seconds
- Each rider will display an event number on the windshield. The number is for identification by the judges and photographers

**Awards**

- Awards will be presented to the top three participants in each class except the four man ride.
