Civilian 'B' division requires a motorcycle with at least 600cc's and 550 lbs. This division is more difficult than the MSF ERC

All exercises set at police training and competition standards. All competitors must have valid: MC endorsement, insurance, inspection (if required), registration, DOT helmet & proper riding equipment/apparel (gloves, above ankle boots, long sleeves) as determined by our Safety Committee
